In making an object with no perfectly usable surface, the Brooklyn-based design quintet — known not only for their own pieces but also for the meticulous fabrication models they create for other architects and artists — has flipped the idea of bedside storage entirely on its head. Not only is the piece, which takes three full days to make, deliberately lopsided, it also eschews catch-all drawers and storage space for cast impressions in the shape of specific bedside objects that include handguns, dildos, paperback novels, lamp-bases, PET bottles, and keys. No need to ask what the designers keep on their own nightstands at home!
